


GANDHI SMRITI LIBRARY

One of the most valuable assets of the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration is the Gandhi Smriti Library. Nearly 1.8 lakh documents on topics as diverse as public administration, international elations, economics, law, and the social sciences are held in the Library, which occupies the first and mezzanine level of the Karamshilla building.

- Making of the Nation- Features the biographies and autobiographies of hundreds of civil services officers.
- **Gyanlok Collection** This section has been purchased from Mr. P. K. Jain to rebuild the library, which was destroyed in a fire incident on May 23rd, 1984. It houses books on the economic, social, philosophical, cultural, and political history of India and gazetteers, manuals, census records, and other papers that date back to 1889.

- Search for the MyLoft app in Google Play (for Android 5 and above) or Apple App Store (for iOS 11 and above)
- Install and open
- Type Ibsnaa and select Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA)
- Click "Login with LDAP (SSO)" and enter your Sargam/Gyan credentials on the screen displayed
