The Centre for Co-operatives and Rural Development (CCRD) at the Academy is functioning since September 1995. The CCRD is engaged in conducting the research in co-operative sector, studying the difficulties faced by the rural poor in organising themselves into co-ops & the successful interventions by co-operatives and RD Institutions in the poverty reduction, developing case studies to impart training in the area of co-operatives and rural development to the officers of the IAS and other Class I services, organising In-service Training Programmes, and providing support to the National Society for the promotion of Development Administration, Research and Training (NSDART) and other research units of the Academy.
