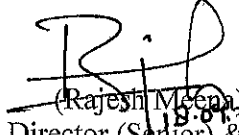

		And (b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 7. 2(a) Reader in Law with 6 years' regular service in the grade and possessing the Education Qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruitment shall also be considered alongwith deputationists and case he/she is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion. (b) Departmental Officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, Deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Note: Only officers belonging to Central Government/State Governments/Union territories are eligible for being considered for appointment on absorption.
